UNIFORM POLICY

Professional appearance and dress code:

All students enrolled at the National Ballet Conservatory are required to follow the National Ballet Conservatory Uniform Policy. Even our youngest students are expected to attend classes in full uniform and will be awarded for their professional appearance and grooming. Wearing your uniform shows that you belong to the NBC and creates a unique and professional school identity.

Please note that the NBC studios have heating facilities and vests, polo necks and any undergarments **must not** be worn under leotards.

Baby Ballet & Introductory Ballet

The uniform for Baby Ballet Age 1-2 is optional. Should you wish to purchase the NBC logo tutu leotard, leather ballet shoes and ballet bag you may do so. However, the sizes of our cardigan, tights, socks and hairband are not suitable for Baby Ballet Age 1-2. Please provide a suitable replacement of your own. The uniform for Baby Ballet Age 2-3 is compulsory, however should you wish for your child to try out the classes before committing to purchasing a uniform we accept that the uniform is purchased at a later stage.

Pre Primary, Primary, Year 1-5, Intermediate & Advanced

For all other classes including Introductory, Pre Primary, Primary, Years 1-5, Intermediate and Advanced uniform is compulsory and must be purchased prior to the start of term. Girls' hair must be pulled back from the face and secured in a bun. Bun must be flat and covered with a transparent hair net using the correct pins and the school hair ribbon. Please note that the traditional crochet bun nets are **not** part of the NBC uniform. Please see [Hair Guidelines PDF](#) which can be downloaded from our website.
